Vending Machines and School Stores

Food sales shall be limited to nutrition services programs, concession stands, student stores and vending machines. The location and quantity of such stands and machines shall be at the discretion of the building principal. All food sales, locations, and preparation sites must meet all sanitation codes and insure compliance with state and federal regulations.

Profits or losses from the sale of food to students, as authorized by this policy, shall be incurred by the party or group responsible for the sale. The administration shall develop internal controls to account and report all cost of food sold to include the following:

1. No cash stored in classrooms.
2. Implement internal controls that require adults to remove cash from vending machines.
3. Money taken from vending machines goes directly to Accounting Clerk for preparation of deposit.
4. No students carrying cash or cash boxes to the Accounting Clerk.
5. Deposits (e.g. money bags) are prepared and stored in a locked location.

The district will control the sale of the following foods of minimal nutritional value (FMNV): carbonated beverages, water ices, chewing gum, hard candy, jelly and gum candies, marshmallow candy, fondant (candy corn-type), licorice, cotton candy and candy-coated popcorn.
