## **Curriculum Development**

The Board believes the content of the curriculum is of vital concern to students, educators, parents, and society. The Board further believes the full involvement of educators and interested local patrons in the curriculum development process will help assure a better education for our students. Therefore, the Board directs the Superintendent to develop procedures for a Curriculum Council to act in an advisory capacity to the Board.

The orderly development of curriculum in grades K-12 requires:

- 1. Planning based on goals;
- 2. Development based on Board adoption;
- 3. Implementation by teachers; and
- 4. Evaluation by administration.

Membership on the Curriculum Council shall include parents, teacher, and administration. The Board shall make appointments.

The Curriculum Council tasks include:

- 1. Stating program goals connecting state goals with course goals;
- 2. Conducting program needs assessments;
- 3. Ranking needs assessments to give order to the curriculum development process;
- 4. Prepare timelines for the curriculum development process;
- 5. Review, approve, and propose adoption of curriculum projects; and
- 6. Review public or parent complaints about the curriculum with the right to make recommendation for resolution.
