The Board believes successful students who demonstrate high levels of scholarship, academic achievement and intellectual talent should be appropriately honored at graduation ceremonies. Selecting a valedictorian, salutatorian and graduates with honors are appropriate. The student with the best seven semester accumulative grade point average shall be named 'valedictorian.' The student with the second best seven semester accumulative grade point average shall be names 'salutatorian.' All students who achieve a seven semester accumulative grade point average of 3.2 or above shall be named 'graduate with honor,' and students earning a seven semester accumulative grade point average of 3.2 with a 3.5 in all CTE (Career Technical Education) courses shall earn the 'CTE graduate with honor' distinction.

Further, the Board authorizes the Superintendent to promulgate rules and procedures to fairly and equitably govern the selection and awarding process. These rules shall be published in the student handbook.
