Closed Campus**

The Board has taken the position that all schools in the district operate under a closed campus concept.

This mandate is designed to provide adequate supervision and confine student activities during the school day. Students who are off campus after arrival or during the noon hour can engage in undesirable activities. With off campus privileges students are provided with an opportunity to become involved with the use and distribution of illegal substances in the general community where adult supervision is lacking.

At the high school level, the building principal has the authority to open the campus as a privilege for grades 9-12. The decision to open campus will be determined on the basis, but not limited to, general student behavior, school and community pride, the absence of litter, and the general conduct of off campus students.

Any student violating the closed campus policy will be subject to school discipline. Any infraction while off campus that also violates civil or criminal law will be referred to the appropriate law enforcement agency.

Students who leave school grounds without authorized permission are considered truant.
