Community Use of District Facilities

The rules and regulations for the use of district buildings and grounds are as follows:

- 1. Persons using district premises at any time for any purpose shall not consume, sell, or be under the influence of alcoholic beverages, or use profanity on the district premises. Violation of this section shall constitute grounds for revocation of the existing contract and/or refusal of the permission to use the building at any future time. Organizations, groups and individuals shall observe tobacco free environment regulations.
- 2. No refreshments may be sold unless special arrangements are made with the principal district office.
- 3. Users are responsible for cleaning the premises.
- 4. Users are responsible for instructing visitors about regulations and are responsible for seeing they are obeyed.
- 5. Street shoes are not allowed on the gym floor. Basketball shoes must be clean.
- 6. All fees are payable in advance.
- 7. The premises shall be left in the same condition as they are found.
- 8. The use of district premises may be denied any user whose members or visitors fail to comply with these rules.
- 9. Special requests for chairs and equipment may be arranged between the user and the principal district office.
- 10. The user shall see that all State, City and district regulations governing safety and security are followed.
- 11. The user shall be responsible for the conduct and control of both patrons and participants.

Prohibited Activities on District Owned Property

The Board is desirous of maintaining the district buildings, grounds and equipment in the best possible condition for both school and community uses. As a result, it is necessary that the following activities be prohibited on all school district-owned property unless they are supervised by school officials or other approved individuals.

- 1. Operation and/or racing of automobiles, motorcycles and other powered vehicles.
- 2. Horseback riding.
