Relations with Law Enforcement Agencies

The Board recognizes that district-wide cooperation with law enforcement agencies is essential for the protection of staff and students for maintain a safe environment in district schools and for safeguarding district property.

The district will encourage programs and activities designed to enrich district curriculum and to develop and promote good citizenship and a healthy attitude toward law enforcement agencies and officials. Law enforcement participation in such programs and activities is encouraged.

Law enforcement officials may enter school facilities if a crime has been committed on district property or to investigate matters concerning staff and students upon request initiated by either agency officials or by district administrators.

The Superintendent will develop rules and procedures to implement this policy, including procedures for handling investigations, administrator requests for assistance, and required referrals to law enforcement agencies, as necessary.
